Dear Esteemed ISAMPE-BC Members,

It gives me great pleasure to present before you the Annual Report of the Indian Society for Advancement of Materials and Process Engineering-Bangalore Chapter (ISAMPE-BC) for the period April 2024-March 2025.

The 23rd Annual General Meeting of ISAMPE-BC was held on Monday, 28th October 2024 at the Aeronautical Society of India Auditorium, AeSI Building, Suranjandas Road, New Thippasandra Post, Bengaluru from 3.30 PM to 6.00 PM. The 11th Dr. B R Somasekhar Memorial Lecture (AGM Technical Lecture) was delivered by Dr. R. Gopalan, Vice President & CEO, Society for Development of Composites, Composites Technology Park, Bengaluru on "Innovation and Entrepreneurship of Composites for Non-Aerospace Applications". This lecture was well-received and appreciated by all the participants. After the lecture, the Business Session of AGM was conducted.

The office bearers have proposed to continue with M/s. Suri and Co as the auditors for the financial year 2024-25 and the AGM approved it.

During the present tenure, ISAMPE-BC conducted a one-week faculty development program for the benefit of students as well as professional members. With a motive of 'training-the-trainers' and bridging the 'industry-academia gap', a one-week faculty development program (FDP) on "Recent Trends in Composite Product Development"-

RTCPD, was conducted from 20-24th January 2025 at the Department of Mechanical Engineering, BMSCE, sponsored by La Fondation Dassault Systèmes and ISAMPE-BC. The program was inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Dr. S.T. Aruna, CSIR-NAL, & Chairman, ISAMPE-BC and the Guest of Honour, Shri. Anil Gunda, Dassault Systèmes in the presence of Head of the Department—Dr. H.M.Shivaprasad. Dr. Sangamesh C. Godi compered the event.-In the keynote address, Dr. S.T.Aruna highlighted the breakthroughs in composites and their applications, challenges and the opportunities for the students. The talk was presided over by guests, dignitaries, participants of the FDP, faculty and students of B.M.S. College of Engineering (BMSCE). This was followed by a talk by Shri. Ravishankar B.N., Scientist. F, Head, Composite Technology Division, Aeronautical Development Estb., DRDO, Bengaluru. His talk covered various aspects of composite fabrication. The afternoon session was a hands-on training for the 25 registered participants. They were trained on the basis of finite element modelling (FEM) and analysis on their own devices and were mentored by Shri. Shashidhar K., Research Scholar, Dept. of Aerospace Engineering, IISc. Bengaluru. The tutorial gave an insight into various aspects of materials selection, finite element meshing and interpretation of the results.

On the second day, Dr. Subbarao, Group Director, Structures, URSC, ISRO delivered the talk on "Composites in Spacecraft Structures". He highlighted various structural components in a spacecraft. Composite materials for space applications, design and development issues pertaining to them. This talk was followed by a talk by Shri. P Jayasimha, Project Director, GSAT-22,23,24, URSC, ISRO on "Fibre Composites – Designer's Perspective". He covered issues with regard to *A*, *B*, *D* matrix and design of composites, typical mechanical properties of composite materials, and classification of fiber and matrix materials. In the afternoon session, Dr. Shivashankar R. Srivatsa, PG-Coordinator, M.Tech. Machine Design program, BMSCE, delivered a lecture on structural composites that included micro-mechanics, macro-mechanics and elements of composite design.

On the third day, Shri.D. Karuppannan, Principal Scientist, Advanced Composites Division (ACD), CSIR-NAL, delivered a lecture on "Emerging Trends in Design of Composites and its Process Engineering". This was followed by a talk by Shri. Manicka Vasagam S., Director, Shriram Institute for Industrial Research, Bengaluru and Former GM, Aircraft Division, HAL On "Composite as Aerospace Material – Challenges in Aircraft Manufacturing". This was followed by a presentation from Dassault Systèmes on

"Introductory Session on BIOVA" with focus on "Materials Studio". This was followed by a technical talk on "Hygro-thermo mechanical modeling and analysis of composite laminate structures" by Dr.Keshav Kumar, Alambya Labs.

On the fourth day, Dr. C.M.Manjunatha, Chief Scientist and Head, Structural Integrity Division, CSIR-National Aerospace Laboratories, Bangalore, delivered a talk on "Fatigue of FRP & Nano Composites". He addressed various issues pertaining to the use of Standards in the Testing of Composites. This talk was followed by a presentation by Dr. M Ramesh Kumar, Head ACD, CSIR-NAL. He talked about maintenance, repair, overhaul and the relevance of NDT in Composite products. The use of modern tools and software in structural health monitoring was touched upon. In the afternoon, a visit of FDP participants to facilities at the Advanced Composites Division (ACD) and Structural Integrity Division (SID), CSIR-NAL was arranged.

On the last day, Shri. Ravindra Singh, Scientist-E, ADA-DRDO, delivered a talk on Design and Manufacturing principles in aerospace composite structural parts. Shri. Ravindra Singh motivated the participants to capitalize on the opportunities in the area of 'composite repair' and shared his experiences on the design for the manufacture of composites. This was followed by a talk on "Innovation and Entrepreneurship of Green and Sustainable Composites" by Dr. R. Gopalan, VP & CEO, RV-TIFAC Composites Design Centre, also VP & CEO, Composites Technology Park, Bengaluru. He shared his experience with sustainable composites and "Make in India". This was followed by a talk on "Composite Materials by Choice" by Dr. Saji D, Professor of Practice, Dept. of Aerospace Engg., IIT-Madras, Director ISAMPE. He shared his vast experience on tool design considerations for composite product design. This was followed by the Valedictory Function. The Presidential address was delivered by the Principal, BMSCE.

In summary, the main activity of ISAMPE BC in the last year was supporting the student chapter at BMSCE. We thank all of you for giving us full support during our tenure (2023-2025) and we assure our guidance and support to the new Governing Council. Best wishes for ISAMPE-BC. Special thanks to M/s Suri & Co for the timely release of the audit report of the chapter. Our gratitude to the Office Bearers of the chapter during FY 23-25, Office bearers of ISAMPE Main Body and other EC members for their support to the chapter.

Report of Activities 2024-2025- Pune Chapter

Major activity taken by ISAMPE Pune Chapter was organization of INCCOM19-2025 conference.

1. INCCOM 19 was organized on 30-31 Jan 2025 at Four Points by Sheraton Hotel, Pune. Prior invitations were sent to ISAMPE Executive board, parent body and members from other ISAMPE Chapters. Invitations were also sent to sister DRDO labs that are working in composites for delegate nominations.

As per the schedule mentioned in brochure for paper submission, around 43 full length papers were received for presentation in the conference. The full length papers received were in the category of advanced mechanics of composites, materials, manufacturing of composites, NDE, SHM, testing and certification and other specialized areas such as green composites, nanocomposites and multifunctional composites.

Based on the quantum of papers received, a total 10 technical sessions were arranged with 5 sessions in parallel each for two days. Each technical session was started with an invited talk by eminent person from the composites field followed by oral presentations from contributing authors. An exhibition was also arranged to showcase technologies from industry and academia.

The conference started with an inaugural session. The dignitaries that graced the occasion were, Dr. Samir Kamat, Chairman DRDO as Chief Guest, Prof. Prateek Kishore, DG ACE as Guest of Honour, Dr. A Rajarajan as ISAMPE President and Dr. Makarand Joshi, ISAMPE Pune Chapter President. After the inaugural address by Chief Guest, inauguration of exhibition was carried out at the hands of Chief Guest. This was followed by talk from platinum sponsor and Keynote address sharing the industry perspective on the composites industry.

After the inaugural function, technical sessions were conducted in parallel on day one. Second day of conference started with a common session where talks from three Gold sponsors were arranged. This was followed by technical sessions in parallel. On second day, after the completion of all technical sessions, valedictory function was organized. Many participants along with representatives from industry expressed their views on the conference and the research topics that were presented.

Apart from participation of contributing authors, many delegates from other chapters of ISAMPE, DRDO labs, ISRO, CSIR labs like NAL attended the conference. Delegates from industry also attended the conference. According to registration data, on first day of conference approximately
